COVID Guidelines for Hostel Students

- It is mandatory for all students travelling from outside to follow the COVID guidelines issued by the state government.
- Every student coming back to the campus will submit a COVID test report (RT-PCR test report), issued within 72 hours stating that she is COVID negative.
- Students joining the hostel are required to submit a consent form duly signed by their parents.
- 'No Mask NO Entry'. Use of mask is mandatory. Besides this they should wash hands frequently with soap and sanitize their hands with proper sanitizer on regular basis. The students need to carry their own sanitizers and other hygienic utilities for their personal use.
- Students should maintain proper physical distancing norms in the hostel mess and should follow different slot for meal timings as specified by the hostel administration so as to avoid overcrowding in the mess.
- Except class hours all hostellers are required to stay in their rooms at all times and should not assemble anywhere for any reason. If found indulging in COVID prohibited activities disciplinary action will be taken against them.
- There will be no weekly outings for the students and all are required to adhere to these directions.
- If a student goes home then she can join the hostel again only after submission of COVID negative test report issued within 72 h.
- The college reserves the right to expel any student from the hostel if the student does not follow the rules and restrictions issued by the college.
- It will be the sole responsibility of the student and their parents to ensure compliance of all the guidelines related to COVID.
- Any student feeling symptomatic should immediately report to the caretaker and warden so that necessary medical aid can be provided.
- As soon as the student reports symptoms of COVID, the parents will be informed and they are required to take care of their ward immediately.
